SAY "NO" TO THE COID PLAS



Say “No” to the COID PLAs

COID has submitted a series of 5 Type II Property Line Adjustments (PLAs) to the City in order to partition this land to be able to sell a large portion to a developer.

- COID’s agreement with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission prevents it from selling the land in its present configuration.
- Two of the resulting parcels do not conform with Bend Development Code [3.1.200.C4](#), which requires street frontage.
- Type II PLAs enable to the public to review the applications and make public comments before the City makes it decision.

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The deadline to submit public comments is
Thursday, October 27, 2022

Because PLA decisions are governed by Bend Development Code, the strongest point you can make is that the City should follow its own codes and say “No” to the COID PLAs.

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Please use your own words in your comments. “Cut and Paste” letters have less credibility.

Other points you may want to emphasize are your personal reasons for keeping the property open to the public as a natural green space, such as:

- Recreation
- Wildlife habitat
- Climate change
